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Americas



Boston

Sorting 22,000+ pounds of food at the Greater Boston Food Bank and helping prepare 200+ meals at Women's Lunch Place

Chicago

Hosting a citizenship clinic and a panel discussion on immigration, and assembling 35 gardening kits, preparing 21 plots for planting and moving 12,500 pounds of soil for a community garden



Houston

Boxing 7,000+ meals, sorting 2,000+ pounds of goods and launching a fundraising campaign for the Houston Food Bank

Los Angeles

Volunteering for six projects centered on homelessness, including hosting two *pro bono* clinics and assembling 300 toiletry kits and 60 meal kits for Downtown Women's Center



New York

Participating in 13 projects, including delivering meals, providing career counseling, preparing 2,500+ care packages, making 1,500+ cards for seniors, participating in a naturalization clinic, staffing a Legal Aid helpline, and collecting food and clothing

Palo Alto

Building 20 bicycles for children and providing legal assistance to immigrant victims of crime, human trafficking or persecution



São Paulo

Hosting a career workshop, including providing advice and conducting mock interviews for 15 underprivileged college students

Participating in nine projects, including partnering with Ronald McDonald House to make dinner for families with sick children, sorting household items for a nonprofit, cleaning a portion of the Potomac River, and collecting food, books and clothing

Cleaning up a local beach, conducting training to help disenfranchised individuals find employment, and collecting and donating food, 17 boxes of books and 50+ kilos of clothing




Seoul

Painting and cleaning a housing center, distributing flashlights and 300+ sandwiches to homeless people, and collecting books, food and clothing




Frankfurt and Munich
