- serving as a member of the trial team defending UBS Real Estate Securities Inc. in a matter involving over \$2 billion in claims asserted by U.S. Bank National Association, the first residential mortgage-backed securities case brought by a trustee to go to trial;
- defending an international financial institution in multijurisdictional securities actions brought by the National Credit Union Administration Board as liquidating agent of corporate credit unions involving alleged violations of state and federal securities laws; and
