In product liability cases, Mr. Martin has represented clients such as Johnson & Johnson in litigation alleging that Tylenol can increase the risk of autism and attention deficit disorder; numerous companies in litigation alleging that baby powder can increase the risk of ovarian cancer and mesothelioma; and Snapchat in litigation brought by state attorneys general. In putative class actions, he has represented a variety of companies, including Ford in a case alleging the company had misleadingly advertised Mustang automobiles.

Mr. Martin also maintains an active *pro bono* practice and has represented voting rights activists and an Afghan family who obtained asylum.
