For example, Ms. Menitove has represented the National Football League in litigation brought by photographers alleging violations of intellectual property and antitrust laws; the National Collegiate Athletic Association in antitrust litigation brought by student-athletes challenging the NCAA's eligibility rules; the National Basketball Association in connection with the league's imposition of discipline upon Los Angeles Clippers owner Donald Sterling; and the PGA TOUR, Inc. in litigation arising from an anti-doping dispute.
